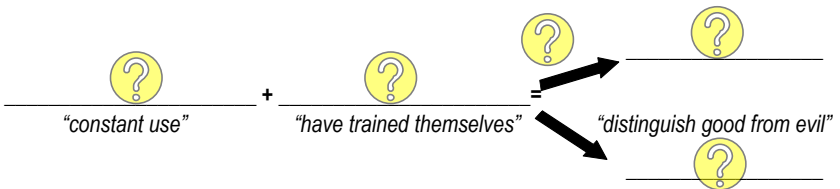
A mature believer is a person who _____  _____ !
