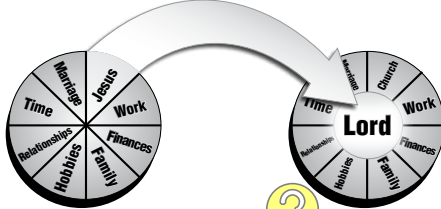


Message #10 – “Jesus is Lord of My WORK”

Review:
