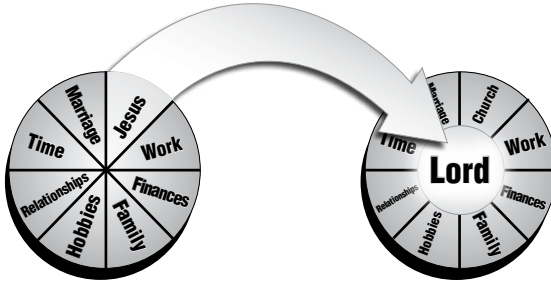


**Message #11 – “Jesus is Lord of my CONFLICT”**

**Review:**

“Lordship” = Jesus’ total control of every area of my life.



**Relational CONFLICT is the area of a Christian’s life where we should be experiencing peace but rather we are encountering increasing tension. Everyone has conflict but we don’t know what to do with it. As Christians, we have to learn to resolve our conflicts.**

**Why do we have conflict? What is the source of your current conflict?**

*“What causes fights and quarrels among you? Don’t they come from your desires that battle within you? You want something but don’t get it. You kill and covet, but you cannot have what you want. You quarrel and fight.” – James 4:1-2*

- #4 - Deal with \_\_\_\_\_ before you deal with \_\_\_\_\_ (Matthew 7:3-5)!
- #5 - Don’t respond to others in the way that they have \_\_\_\_\_ to you (Romans 12:17)!
- #6 - \_\_\_\_\_ to see the best in others (1 Corinthians 13:7)!
- #7 - Give Christ the chance to \_\_\_\_\_ the situation!
